Three Points of Contact

UPON ARRIVING AT YOUR DESTINATION
TAKE THE FOLLOWING PRECAUTIONS:

1. Immediately put your vehicle in park
2. Apply the parking brake
3. Turn the key to the off position

As you enter or exit your vehicle remember



THREE POINTS OF CONTACT

When entering or exiting the vehicle keep three points of contact with the vehicle at all times: two hands and a foot. If one hand or foot slips, two other limbs will be in contact to reduce your risk of a slip or fall



Always hold on to the door, steering wheel, or handgrips to help you maintain your balance as you transfer your weight from sitting to standing

Check the surface before exiting for hazards that might contribute to losing your balance, or twisting an ankle

Do not slide from the driver's seat; this increases your chances of injury



There are many different hazards to be aware of as you perform work in and around your vehicle. As we move from winter into spring, we can all still experience icy conditions. Please be on your guard at all times when moisture is present in any fashion.

ADP TotalPay® Cards

As many of you know, the ADP pay cards have been sent to most employees. New employees will be receiving theirs shortly, if they are not already signed up for direct deposit. The hope is that with 100% electronic delivery of funds many of the issues with the mailing of checks will go away completely (most importantly, no more lost checks in the mail) and all employees will be able to enjoy the benefits of electronic pay.

These benefits include:

- ♦ Money is available on your card bright and early on your pay date.
- ♦ The card can be used just like a debit card for point-of-sale transactions (\$600 daily purchase limit)
- ♦ Three checks are included with each packet and you can order more for free. These checks can be used at any Walmart location to withdraw all cash from your account down to \$0.01.
- ♦ Withdraw cash at any ATM up to \$400 daily. Please check the LOCATOR link below for surcharge-free ATM's in your area (most areas have many locations).
- ♦ Transfer the entire balance to your local bank account.
- ♦ Visit www.moneynetwork.com and register for an account (if you have a card) to see the many online tools available, including free balance and history information.
- ♦ Locate Surcharge-Free ATM's and Free Check Cashing at this link: **moneynetwork.via.infonow.net/locator/**
